The second printing has three textual differences with the first copy. Two are the addition of the 70 Bond St. address and the printer's notice on p. 192 reference to the Canadian company. The printer's notice on the copy without the address, like virtually all WCs, refers to the British company as does the other four printings of *Tobacco*

Road. There are also differences on the copyright page.

All printings of *Tobacco Road* have a copyright date of 1947 but WCs from 246 to 291 have a 1946 date. WC 292, in addition to having the first 1947 date, has the first title page identical to the first printing of *Tobacco Road* with no street address. This continued (except for 303) until 307. After 308 the title page is the same as the second printing of *Tobacco Road*. This suggests that *Tobacco Road*, notwithstanding a number indicating early 1946, was first printed in early 1947. The 70 Bond address was used until late 1948 so the second printing was no later than this. The third printing with the 53 Avenue Road address was late 1948 or 1949. The fourth through sixth printings have the printing date.

There are slight differences in the colours of the covers. They are most obvious in the area surrounding the author's name. The first printing is blue and the second light purple. The third printing is similar to the second printing and the fourth through sixth printings are similar to the first copy.
