At the time that **Banner Books** was initiated Hearst already published another paperback imprint, **Avon Books**, which they had acquired in 1959 after the original publisher's death. Banner Books was conceived as a completely separate operation, having no interaction with Avon at all. Although Banner published an interesting array of books, with sometimes striking covers, it seems not to have made any impact on the marketplace and was cancelled after nine months. In all, 36 books were issued, four per month. Only two books were non-fiction, the rest being mostly genre fiction. Thirteen books were reprints, the rest were originals. All books seen were stated first printings; the imprint died so quickly that additional printings are unlikely.

11 books were mystery or crime novels; another 6 belonged to the still-emerging espionage genre. There were 9 westerns and 2 war novels. The genres of science fiction, romance, adventure and gothics (also a recently established genre) were represented by a single book each, although one of the espionage titles doubled as an SF novel, blurring the genre boundaries. The two remaining novels were "contemporary fiction." There were no collections or anthologies, obviating the need for a "contents" index.

Most of the reprints make no statements about the completeness of their texts; I checked three of them against prior editions and found no obvious deletions in two and one sentence missing in the other.

Various Banner Books advertised other books in the line, sometimes prematurely. One western that was initially advertised as a 40 cent book was actually released in the 50 cent line. Several others were advertised that were still unpublished when the line was cancelled; ironically, most of them were eventually released as **Avon Books**. The ones that were advertised are documented in the Unpublished Titles section (Appendix I) below. Banner Books had a much longer pipeline however; Ted White has reported<sup>1</sup> selling them two outlines for SF novels, neither of which he had begun writing when the line was folded.

Banner did not print any cover art credits, and I have seen only two covers with signatures. Two others have been identified from other sources. The Bookscans database includes 34 of the 36 covers; a scan of one other has been elsewhere. Only the Arlene Hale has not been seen. Three books used photos as cover illustrations and one had a purely typographical cover. All the rest featured painted covers.

The books are fragmented into four numerical sequences. Since I have a month of publication for all but one book (easily inferred), I have included a concordance (Appendix II) that shows the monthly issuance of all the books in a single timeline.
