In the spectrum of fly-by-night publishers that litter this index, **Flagship Books** may be in a class by itself. It has proven to be one of the hardest to document. It is one of the few publishers that I know nothing about; I have no idea what Caravelle Books was: who owned it, edited it, or distributed it, or what else Caravelle may have published.

Although all of the titles appear to be known, several are so obscure that I can find no documentation of them outside collectors' publications and, in some cases, can only guess as to whether they are fiction or non-fiction, original or reprint. A partial bibliography by Bill Denholm in *Books Are Everything*, vol. 1 #2, was extremely helpful and filled in many gaps. The remaining titles appear only in Graham Holroyd's price guide, from which I have extracted what little information I have.

With the exception of the first dozen titles, there are no copyright registrations¹, hence little opportunity to identify the large number of unknown authors or to discern a reliable pattern of issuance. Two pairs of books, as noted in the pop-ups, have their copyright notices swapped, causing no end of fun.

There are virtually no house ads in the books, indicating a severely restricted circulation. Many of the novels are earnest attempts at socially conscious contemporary fiction, indicating a seriousness of intent on the part of the publisher that is belied by its embarrassing lack of promotion.

The handful of copyright registrations suggest that the books were initially issued monthly in fours. If this pattern continued, there was only five more months' worth of books released in 1967 and eight months' worth issued in 1968. This is probably a reasonable estimation, which, allowing for the possibility of a couple skipped months, would bring the imprint to a close around August or September 1968. There aren't nearly as many Flagship Books as it would appear at first glance; for no apparent reason the numbers skip from 736 to 837, leaving a total run of only 64 books.

As far as I can tell, all but 4 titles were original. Ten books are non-fiction of various sorts. One book is a collection of songs. Various types of mystery/suspense titles account for 20 books; there are 3 science fiction titles, 2 westerns and 2 war novels. The other 26 titles, accounting for about half of the fiction, are mostly contemporary fiction with a few that might be considered sleaze.

My thanks to Associate Professor Bruce Tabb, Special Collections Librarian at the University of Oregon Libraries, for confirming that a manuscript by Cole Freedman in their possession was the same as **Flagship Book 714** and thus freeing me to use the pseudonym reference attached to it.

There are no cover credits in any of the books and only a few are signed. One name may not be properly interpreted, so I have included scans of the signature. Several covers are photographic and are particularized. 43 covers appear in the Bookscans database, including the variant edition of 717; scans of 7 others have been seen elsewhere.

¹ Two late books were also copyrighted but they were probably registered by the author and the publication dates listed are probably not reliable.
