These books were published by the legendary Maurice Girodias, né Kahane (1919-1990), who had moved his erotic publishing ventures (**Olympia Press**) from France to the U.S. in 1967. His porn had limited success in America and his distributors eventually convinced him to start up this mass-market imprint instead.

Initially, it was a revival, with separate numbering, of a series called **Venus Books**, which had been started by **Grove Press** several years earlier. The books were first labeled **Venus Freeway Press**, but the "Venus" was dropped at the beginning of 1974. The December 1973 volumes were inconsistent in the use of "Venus" in different places on a given book and inconsistent from book to book as to where the variations occurred.

An examination the ads in the earliest volumes reveals that they are reciprocal within discrete groups; from this it is possible to infer that the first 28 volumes were issued in groups of 7, probably starting in September 1973. It appears that 8 books were issued in January 1974, after which there seems to have been a hiatus. It was Jerry Boyajian who pointed out to me that all the volumes seen above #2035 have a date printed at the end of the text. This is in the form "6-74" and is probably an indication of the month the book was printed. This form of dating is common in the low-priced knock-offs issued by companies like **Unibooks** and **Magnum Books** in this same time period, and may be an indication that Girodias had already lost control of the company. In any case, the remaining books are all dated 6-, 8-, or 9-74 and there are not enough unseen volumes to account for a set of releases in July so it is assumed there were none.

It is difficult with an imprint like this to be sure that one has captured all the titles. About a third of the books are porn, and are difficult to document outside of house ads in the other books. My gut feeling is that #s 2058 through 2060 were probably issued, but no amount of digging has identified them.

Harpo Speaks! was advertised in several mail order ads as #2040, with a price of \$1.25. The only copies that can be otherwise documented are all numbered 2070 and priced at \$1.75. With any other publisher I would assume the existence of 2040 simply by the existence of the ads, but we are dealing with Maurice Girodias, who was not above promoting a book that hadn't appeared. I have listed both editions on the chance that it was first issued at \$1.25 in the usual print-run for a newsstand-only paperback and that it sold out so quickly that Girodias went back to press with a seriously larger, higher priced printing. If that is the case, it would be the only **Freeway Press** book with multiple printings.

Besides the one phantom book whose number was advertised, #2061, several other titles have been mentioned over the years as planned **Freeway Press** titles that, to the best of my knowledge, were never issued. Web sites about Victor Bockris and/or Andrew Wylie mention a book titled *Springtime for Hitler*, which was apparently turned in and paid for but was not issued. In the second Operator 5 book *The Melting Death* was forecast as #3. Had the series continued, it would undoubtedly have been #4. Recent versions of Allen J. Hubin's Crime Fiction bibliography have added an eighth K'ing Kung-Fu title: *The Devil's Triangle*. This too is a phantom title.



Girodias is the kind of person about whom many apocryphal stories circulate. One such is the story,¹ that the distribution of *President Kissinger* was suppressed when the entire print run disappeared from the distributor's warehouse. However, a news item in *Publishers Weekly*² reported that Kable refused to distribute the book and that Girodias had distributed it himself, selling 70,000 copies, which may be an exaggeration in the other direction. In my experience it is no harder to find than any of the other non-porn titles.

Of the 56 identified books, 26 were new, 30 were reprints and 1 a presumed re-issue. 21 were porn, including 14 re-issues of old Olympia novels. Genre fiction included 8 adventure novels, 2 westerns, 6 books that qualify as mystery or espionage, and one gothic. There were 4 science fiction novels; however, the 7 adventure novels, 3 of the espionage novels and the one gothic also qualify as science fiction to a greater or lesser extent. One novel is too random to categorize. The 14 non-fiction books fall into 3 main groups: 2 biographies, 7 occult, and 3 sex books, with only one title falling outside those categories. There were no anthologies and only one collection, so I have sub-listed the contents in the author Index and eschewed a separate contents index.

Freeway Press was pretty good about crediting the cover artists, even for the photographic covers. Unfortunately, secondary sources rarely repeat these credits and too few books have been seen to be comprehensive in this regard. 28 of the 56 covers appear in the Bookscans database; scans of 7 others were seen elsewhere.
